What will I learn?

Throughout Key Stage 3 Drama, we endeavour to engage and challenge students with a series of exciting and thought-provoking schemes of work that will deepen their understanding of the drama techniques, develop their skills, and hopefully build an awareness of real and artistic worlds around them.

We anticipate that students will enjoy the practicality of the lessons, and be encouraged to participate. Our students will gain knowledge that is transferable to a variety of other subjects within the school curriculum as well as skills that are crucial in lifelong learning: leadership, teamwork and to have the confidence to voice their opinion and feel valued.

What will I do?

There is an opportunity to explore a range of stimuli including video clips, diary extracts, poems, scripts, paintings and music. Students will work as individuals or in small groups to build and develop a practical response inspired by the stimuli. Units of work are based on the following themes:

- Physical Theatre
- Pantomime
- Holocaust
- Scripted (Blood Brothers)
- Shakespeare
- Devising

How will I be assessed?

Students are assessed for each project, for Creating, Performing or Responding. They are given levels relating to Arts Council guidelines.
