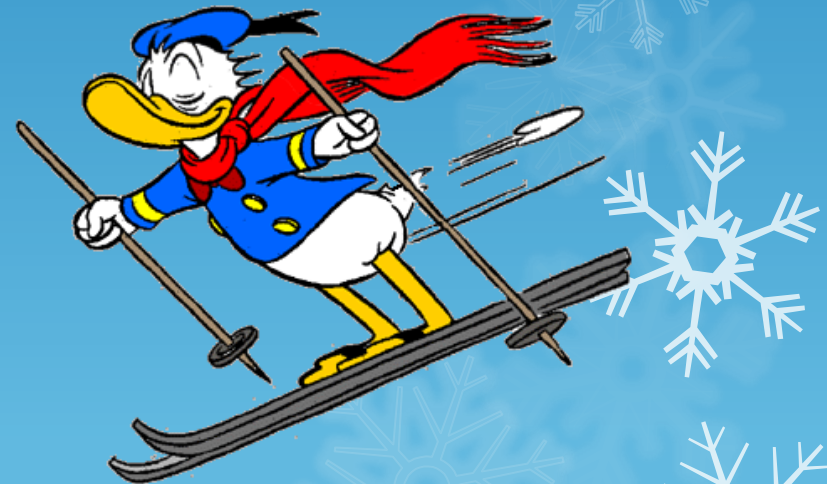

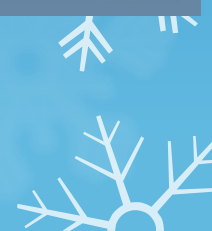

Accomodation

Injury prevention

- Helmet policy – All students must wear a helmet as a legal requirement in Italy.
- If you do not own one it will be provided free by Interski together with your skis, boots and poles.
- No 'Go-pros' on helmets.
- No 'Go-pros' on chest harnesses.



Learn to ski lessons prior to trip.



In order to maximise skiing in the beautiful Italian mountains it is a good idea to have a few dry ski slope lessons prior to the trip.



The aim of these sessions is to enable individuals to 'learn the basics' and have some degree of familiarity and control before actually embarking on their ski holiday.



This prior preparation accelerates progress over the first couple of days and enables students to understand basic instructions and progress to the higher slopes more quickly.



I have preliminary booked two 1.5 hour sessions on Tues 24th Feb and Tues 3rd March 2026 starting at 7.15 and going on until 8.45pm.



Sessions can be booked in multiples of 10 per group and the approximate cost for two sessions would be £52 if we have full groups as we pay per instructor.

WHAT SKI WEAR AND SKI ACCESSORIES DO I NEED TO TAKE ON MY SKI COURSE?

TAKING THE RIGHT CLOTHING AND SKI ACCESSORIES WILL ENSURE YOU'RE WARM, DRY AND SAFE ON THE MOUNTAIN.



BASE LAYER / THERMALS

- NOT cotton, it dries very slowly
- Warm and quick drying
- Thermal or fleece
- Proper long-sleeved thermal top



SKI SOCKS

- Specialist ski socks
- Minimum 2 pairs
- Snug fitting
- Wear only one pair



MID LAYER

- Provides warmth
- Filling of your clothing sandwich
- Allows temperature regulation
- Several thin layers
- Fleeces or light jacket



SKI TROUSERS / SKI PANTS

- Waterproof
- Windproof
- Fully taped seams
- Gaiters
- Extra padding



SKI JACKET

- Waterproof
- Windproof
- Fully taped seams
- Breathable
- Lots of pockets



SKI GLOVES / MITTENS

- Waterproof
- Warm
- padded
- Good grip
- Snug but not too tight
- Velcro strap or draw string to minimise heat loss



SUNGLASSES

- Can be useful
- Ensure a good fit
- Provide adequate UV protection
- Plastic frame



GOGGLES

- Essential for when it's snowing
- Ensure they fit correctly
- Double / anti fog lens
- Orange or green lens
- Make sure they are helmet compatible



SKI HELMET

- Legal requirement in many European resorts
- Ensure correct fit
- Will be provided if you do not have your own.

- Buff or neck warmer
- Snow boots
- Sun cream and lip salve
- Après ski wear
