ANTI-BULLYING POLICY



What is bullying behaviour?

Bullying behaviour is when someone is REPEATEDLY MEAN to someone, ON PURPOSE, over a PERIOD OF TIME.

BULLYING CAN BE:

- **Physical** – hitting, kicking, sexual assault and damaging others' property
- **Verbal** – deliberate humiliation, name calling/teasing or spreading rumours
- **Cyber** – sending horrid texts, emails, making nasty comments online, posting photos/videos without permission
- **Social** – peer pressure, excluding others from your group

If I am bullied or see others bullied?

You should:

- Stay Calm
- Walk away
- Tell someone you trust

You should not:

- Keep it to yourself
- React with unkind words or actions
