What will I learn?

In Year 9 all students follow a course to equip them with the basics of the language as Spanish is an 'ab initio' course. They study topics such as My Family, At Home, Environment, Snack and Drinks, Daily Routine, School and Free Time. After new language is presented students practise it thoroughly in guided exercises before they go on to using it productively.

What will I do?

Students will have to complete homework on a regular basis. They will have to be prepared to speak in front of other students, role plays will range from ordering food to talking about their school uniform. They will gradually learn to write in Spanish using opinion and justification, adjectives, tenses and link words. This will enable them to complete an assessment at the end of each unit.

How will I be assessed?

There will be an assessment booklet in each of the students files in which they will record their levels and progress. At the end of the different units, students will be assessed on different skills, Reading, Listening, Speaking and Writing. All students will complete six assessments on twelve different topics.
